Development and Peace: Since the beginning of the war, we have been supporting our Caritas network partners in Ukraine and neighbouring countries who have been actively responding to the humanitarian crisis through their local Caritas centres and many parish communities. The funds we have sent to our partners are already hard at work, meeting the urgent needs of fleeing or isolated Ukrainians (food, water, temporary housing, medical care, medications, childcare, psychosocial support, safe transportation, etc.). Caritas Ukraine and Caritas Spes have helped around 900,000 vulnerable Ukrainians to date. For example, they have been providing temporary free accommodation on their various premises in Ukraine to displaced people who need a safe place where they can stay and think about their next steps, relax, shower, enjoy hot meals and take advantage of the children's play areas. In addition, Caritas Ukraine is currently operating in the villages around Bucha, a town recently liberated from occupation near Kyiv, as well as in Zaporizhzhia, where humanitarian goods such as food and toiletries are distributed daily to hundreds of families.
